Agreements by Contestants

1. I agree that I am a person of integrity and will continue to
be a person of good moral character, now and at all times

during the Pageant and during my reign as a titleholder for the Mrs/Ms USA & Mrs/Ms/Miss/Teen/Classic, Worldwide.

2. I agree that I am a citizen of the United States of America and a legal resident of the state that I represent, or I attend college or own property in the state of my entry for State, USA entry. OR.....
3. I agree that I am a citizen of the Country/Nation (outside of the USA) that I am representing.
4. I agree that I was genetically born female, and will remain female during my reign.
5. I agree that if I am a married contestant, I have been married for at least 6 months prior to the Worldwide Crowning Event of USA & Worldwide Pageant and that I am married to a genetically born male.
6. I agree that as a Teen Contestant I am no younger than 13 and no older than 18 on July 1st of the competition year. I agree that I have never been married and I do not have any children.
7. I agree that as a Miss Contestant I am no younger than 19 and no older than 30 on July 1st of the competition year. I agree that I have never been married and I do not have any children.
8. I agree that as a Ms. Contestant I am no younger than 25+ on July 1st of the competition year. I can be single, married, widowed or divorced; with or without children.
9. I agree that as a Mrs. Contestant I am no younger than 21 and no older than 55 on July 1st of the competition year. I have been married at least 6 months prior to the date of the Worldwide Crowning event and will send a copy of my marriage license to Worldwide Pageants.
10. I agree that as a Classic I am no younger than 47+ on July 1st of the competition year I agree to send a copy of my birth

- certificate to Worldwide Pageants within 30 days.
11. I agree that I will conduct myself above reproach and I have not appeared nude or semi-nude in any photographs, video or film or modeling at any time prior to or during the Mrs/Ms USA and Mrs/Ms/Miss/Teen/Classic Worldwide Pageant.
 12. I agree that I will hold to only the highest moral and ethical standards as a titleholder, and I agree to present a positive image of Worldwide Pageants at all times, before, during and after the international Pageant.
 13. I agree that I will act in a professional manner by being courteous and polite during the Mrs/Ms USA and Mrs./Ms./Miss/Teen/Classic Worldwide Pageant and while representing a state, national, or regional title.
 14. I agree that I will continually act in a professional manner, and be polite and courteous to the directors and other titleholders and will not be late to any of the scheduled events at the Pageant.
 15. I agree that I will not use the title name (such as Miss Teen Worldwide, Miss Worldwide, Ms. Worldwide, Mrs. Worldwide or Classic Worldwide) in any electronic address or Social Media without the written approval of the Mrs/Ms USA and Mrs/Ms/Miss/Teen/Classic Worldwide Pageant.
 16. I agree that the Fan Pages for Mrs/Ms USA and Mrs/Ms/Miss/Teen/Classic Worldwide on Facebook will be created, supervised and managed by the Director of Worldwide Pageants. The USA/Worldwide Titleholders may be given Editing rights so that they have access to the fan page and can upload their photos and post their appearances. In this regard, Worldwide Pageant will be able to keep the international Fan Pages running indefinitely each year a new Worldwide Titleholder is crowned.
 17. I agree that as a titleholder for an individual state or region

in the United States, I will create, supervise and manage my own (public figure) fan pages, (this is NOT the international title.)

18. I agree that as a titleholder for an individual country or national region (other than the United States,) I will create, supervise and manage my own (public figure) fan pages, (this is NOT the international title.)
19. I agree that I will present a very positive image while networking with sites such as Twitter, Facebook, Instagram, blogging, snapchat or message boards, etc. I will not use any negative postings, inappropriate photos or inappropriate language. I agree not to use cussing, foul, or bad language. Additionally, I agree that I will not publicly post gossip, malicious, and/or slanderous remarks on any public media. I realize that if I do this I will be disqualified immediately.
20. I agree that if I create an email address with my title I will always use the year of my title. Example: (mrsworldwide 2019@gmail.com.)
21. I agree that I will not at any time make comments that are considered to be bullying, false or slanderous, that pertain to my fellow Titleholders, judges, the Mrs/Ms USA and Mrs/Ms/Miss/Teen/ Classic Pageant, staff, sponsors, or any party directly related or connected to the Pageant. Any such comment or correspondence may cause me to be disqualified and/or lose my title.
22. I agree to use good sportsmanship at ALL times before, during and after the pageant. If I am bullying others or acting in a verbally abusive or disruptive manner I will be disqualified immediately and will be asked to leave the premises. If I do not win the coveted title, I will behave with the utmost grace, dignity and positive reactions. The pageant is videotaped and any temper tantrums or inappropriate behaviors will be permanently recorded on DVD. Good sportsmanship means that I will agree that the

- judges' decisions are final, no matter what the outcome is.
23. I will not be managed by any other person or business, other than Mrs/Ms USA and Mrs/Ms/Miss/Teen/Classic Worldwide Pageants in relation to my title, without written permission prior.
 24. The Director must approve all photos and media with the Mrs/Ms USA and Mrs/Ms/Miss/Teen/Classic Worldwide name attached.
 25. All issues relating to a titleholder's poor conduct will be determined solely by the Mrs/Ms USA and Mrs/Ms/Miss/Teen/Classic Worldwide Pageants.
 26. I agree to make a minimum of **TWO** appearances a month during my reign.
 27. I agree that I will return to the 2020 pageant if I am crowned with a 2019 national title - Mrs/Ms USA, or a 2019 international title - Mrs/Ms/Miss/Teen Classic Worldwide; to crown my successor, if a pageant is held (Omaha, Nebraska.) If there are any US Ambassadors or Worldwide United Queens, they will not need to return unless instructed by the CEO 60 days before the National Pageant.
 28. I agree not to compete in any other pageant system during my year's reign.
 29. I agree that if I am crowned with an international or a national title, I will abide by the USA/Worldwide Queen's handbook and all the commandments/agreements found in such.
 30. I agree that if I resign before the 2019 pageant, I will forfeit my title, crown and sash and will not obtain a refund. Additionally, if I should be crowned with a 2019 USA or 2019 Worldwide title at the 2019 Pageant, I agree that if I resign before crowning my next successor, I will forfeit my title, crown and sash and will not obtain a refund.
 31. I agree not to participate in: excessive drinking, drunkenness and drug abuse, or any activities that would

- shock, offend or insult the community.
32. I agree that if I am arrested or have committed an alleged crime, I will forfeit my title, crown and sash.
 33. I agree not to hold USA & Worldwide Pageants, and Worldwide Pageants, LLC (including directors and staff) responsible for any injuries, or loss of personal property while I am a titleholder in this pageant.
 34. I agree not to hold Mrs/Ms USA and Mrs/Ms/Miss/Teen/Classic Worldwide Pageant, and Worldwide Pageants, LLC responsible for any travel expenses or prizes not given (if any) while I am a titleholder in this pageant.
 35. I agree that if I am violating any of the above stated rules, I could forfeit my title, crown and sash.

If I forfeit my title, I will stop making appearances and will return my crown and sash to the Director in good condition.

Release

36. By executing this Agreement, Contestant consents to the display, transmittal, distribution or other use of Contestant's name, image, voice or likeness and its/their release, publication, exhibition, or reproduction which may be used in whole or in part without restriction or limitation in any medium, including by photograph, video, audio taping, or the internet, by Pageant and/or its affiliates for any purposes as determined in Pageant's sole discretion, including but not limited to webcasting, for public relations, in news articles or telecasts, in advertising, commercial purposes, or by inclusion on Pageant's website. Contestant hereby releases and holds harmless Pageant, its officers,

agents, and employees, and each and all persons and entities involved from any and all claims, demands, causes of actions (including any rights of privacy or rights of publicity), liabilities, damages, rights, costs, and expenses connected with the display, transmittal, distribution, or other use of Contestant's name, image, voice or likeness, including the taking, recording, or publication of such interviews, photographs, computer images, video recordings, or sound recordings which Contestant has or may in the future have related to the foregoing. Contestant further agrees that by executing this Agreement, Contestant waives all rights she may have to any claims for payment or royalties in connection with any exhibition, televising, or other publication, in any medium and whether online or otherwise, of the above materials, whether such materials have been created prior to the date of this Agreement or on or after the date of this Agreement. Contestant also waives any right to inspect or approve any photograph, sound or video recording, or film taken or created (or to be taken or created) by Pageant, or the person or entity designated by it. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing. Contestant agrees that any and all materials previously created by or on behalf of Pageant which contain Contestant's name, image, voice, or likeness, and whether or not used for advertising or commercial purposes, are intended to fall within the scope of this release and Contestant waives any and all rights she may have had regarding Pageant's use of such materials prior to the execution of this Agreement. Contestant understands Pageant is conducting such activities in express reliance upon the foregoing and Contestant represents and agrees that she is legally capable and authorized to authorize the release and grant the rights granted to Pageant hereunder.

Contestant Indemnifications

37. Contestant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Pageant, its directors, officers, agents, employees, and any other partner thereof, venture connected therewith, and/or any related person (collectively, the “indemnitees”) from all claims, demands, actions, costs, expenses, liabilities, judgments, causes of action, proceedings, suits, losses and damages of any kind or nature, which are threatened or brought against, or are suffered or incurred by, an indemnitee which arise out of or related to:
- a. death or injuries or damage to person or property sustained by Contestant during participation in the contests, appearances, and activities contemplated herein except to the extent caused by an indemnitee’s intentional or willful act. Contestant understands and assumes the risk of any and all activities involved with the pageant.
 - b. the Pageant’s use of photographs of other likenesses, biographical material, voice, videotapes, and/or other recordings of Contestant. Any such recited material may be used, reproduced, exhibited, telecast, broadcast, and published in such a manner that Pageant deems advisable in its sole discretion.
 - c. from any action for compensation (except as provided elsewhere in this agreement) damages, injunctive relief, or other relief, including but not limited to any action for invasion of privacy in connection with the use on any rights granted herein by the Contestant to the Pageant, and the Contestant agrees that she will not permit such use except as authorized by Pageant in writing.
 - d. the negligent or willful wrongful act or omission of Contestant or the failure or breach of any of the representations, warranties, covenants or conditions of Contestant contained in this Agreement or any other

agreement between the Parties.

38. The Provisions of this Agreement shall be deemed severable and in the event that any provision or portion thereof shall be deemed to be void and of no effect or invalid, such finding shall not affect the validity and enforceability of the remainder of the provisions.
39. Each of the parties is an independent contractor under this Agreement, and nothing herein shall be construed to create a partnership, joint venture, or agency relationship between the parties hereto. Nothing herein shall be deemed to create a partnership, joint venture, agency, or employer/employee relationship and that Contestant agrees she is acting as an independent contractor.
40. The interpretation, validity, performance, and any disputes arising out of, this Agreement will be governed by the laws of the state of Nebraska without respect to its conflicts of laws principles. Contestant consents to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of the State of Nebraska, located in Douglas County.
41. This Agreement is/and shall be binding upon the Contestant in inure to the benefit of the legal or personal representatives, successors and/or assigns of the Pageant. Contestant acknowledges that she may not assign any of her rights or obligations under this Agreement without Pageant's prior written consent, which may be withheld in Pageant's sole discretion
42. Contestant agrees that she will purchase a minimum of one pageant program booklet. This booklet will showcase the Contestant and her sponsors. The cost of the booklet is in the range of \$20-\$25 dollars. Contestant's family and/or friends may assist in the purchase of other program booklets. Proceeds will go to the Love Without Boundaries Foundation. Contestant agrees to sell at least 4 booklets to their family and friends. Contestant agrees that they will

have an ad ready for the program booklet that will be submitted to Pageant office no later than June 1st of the competition year.

43. Contestant agrees that all rules, restrictions and regulations promulgated or recited here apply to her and are binding equally in content to the state and international titles. She further acknowledges that she has had an opportunity to carefully review all the terms of this agreement and has had an opportunity to discuss said terms with the representatives of Pageant, and her own legal counsel if she desired.
44. This Agreement contains the entire and full agreement between the parties and no modifications hereto or additions hereto, whether made prior to, contemporaneously with or subsequent hereto shall be binding upon the Pageant unless said agreement is amended in writing and signed by both parties. This Agreement is effective as of the date first above written.
